We will expand the children's science and mathematics learning and lead them toward discovery by encouraging their natural curiosity, noticing what they are doing during play with water, shadow, or sand, and asking open-ended WHAT questions like: What do you notice about how it's moving? • What happened there? • What did you try? • What have you changed about what you are making? • What are some of the ideas you have talked about that you haven't tried yet? • What have you seen other people trying? • What do you notice about _____? • What do you think will happen if we _____?
